TITLE OF BILL : An act to amend the labor law, the state finance law, the general municipal law and the education law, in relation to including certain sports equipment under the special provisions applicable for the purchasing of apparel by the state university of New York and the city university of New York

PURPOSE OR GENERAL IDEA OF BILL : To include sports equipment to the provisions of the "sweatfree schools bill", which allows both boards of education and public colleges to consider labor standards when evaluating bids.

SUMMARY OF SPECIFIC PROVISIONS :

Section 1: amends Section 213-a of the labor law by adding sports equipment

Section 2: defines "sports equipment"

Section 3: amends subdivision 12 of section 103 of the general business law

Section 4: amends subdivision 6 of section 104-b of the general municipal law

Section 5: amends subdivision 6 of section 6302 of the education law

Section 6: is the effective date

JUSTIFICATION : This legislation would allow boards of education and public colleges to be able to consider labor standards when they are purchasing "sports equipment". Recent laws have provided for labor standards to be considered when purchasing apparel, this legislation would just extend this provision to the purchase of sports equipment.

PRIOR LEGISLATIVE HISTORY : New Bill

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS : None to State

EFFECTIVE DATE : This act shall take effect September 1, 2003, and shall respectively apply to bids issued after such date.
